### ***DFO Development: Laurel Mackinnon***

#### ***Area Coordinator Windermere N/hood Watch***

Despite earlier indications that DFO would not apply to increase parking, they submitted an application for 359 more parking spaces to BCC around 10 May.

Representatives of Windermere and the two townhouse communities have confirmed our community's opposition to more parking with the Mayor and Deputy Mayor. We are seeking a meeting with BCC traffic planners to reiterate our opposition on the grounds that the roads, Goggs Rd in particular, are unsuited for that level of

traffic. DFO plans to open in November. Now is the time to start lobbying BCC and the QLD Police about managing traffic, parking and other safety concerns around the opening and during the pre-Christmas rush, especially with the summer school holidays being just a few weeks after the opening.

***Local development update: Cr Felicity Farmer***

**DFO:** Council has just received the DFO application to build 359 additional car parks. You can view the application via the Council website ([www.brisbane.qld.gov.au](http://www.brisbane.qld.gov.au)) via the building and development button. (File ref A001823902 at the enquiry page.) Alternatively, pop into the Ward Office to view a hard copy. Although this development application is code assessable, I will be opposing it in support of the efforts of your Association and other key resident groups to protect our local suburbs and lifestyle.

**CSR:** I have continued to represent the concerns of residents in Council especially on the basis of ongoing nuisance noise and odour from the sites. This is a key opportunity for locals to have these addressed once and for all. No approval has been given at the time of writing. Please feel welcome to call me on 3407 7000 at any time. Otherwise I will see you at your next Association meeting.
