Welcome to the latest newsletter from your local Residents Association! It's time for another quarterly meeting, this one incorporating our Annual General Meeting. Hope you can come along.

You may have heard the good news about the CSR development application. The application has been approved, but with substantial restrictions on CSR's ongoing operations. Manufacturing is not permitted overnight or on Sundays. Odor from the site must not be detected past the site boundaries. The success of the community's objection is largely due to the efforts of you, our residents, who have continued to object to Council.

Construction of the DFO continues, as you can see from the highway. Our current focus with this project is to assist in any way we can with the creation of a successful parking restriction system for the Winderemere area. Residents close to the DFO are currently being asked for feedback about a proposed system developed by Council. This Association has also been offered the opportunity to respond.

There has been substantial footpath and kerbing work in the suburb. As examples, the new kerbing along Oldfield Road near Seventeen Mile Rocks Road, and the extended footpath from Christopher Place to Jindalee Creek.

Numbers on the new 467 and 468 buses remain fairly low. Without our support, we may lose these services. They do offer an offpeak service that the 451 service (Darra Train Station to Sinnamon Park) does not. If you are catching the train home from the city at night, try catching the 468 from Oxley Station at 7:36pm, 8:36pm, or 9:36pm, Monday through Friday.

It will take you from Oxley Train Station, to the Monier Shopping Centre, through Sinnamon Park, and on to Winderemere.

The traffic subcommittee is still being formed, to examine traffic calming in the area due to hoons and ratrunners. A petition supporting traffic calming was started at our Centenary Rocks stall. If you are concerned about local traffic, and would like to voice your opinion, or even join the subcommittee, please do so at our meeting.
