1. CSR 1 or CSR tile factory, 140 & 160 Bellwood St. Darra. Update on the application lodged for:
 - a. DA - Material Change of Use Development Permit - Industry (Trim line operation for CSR Concrete Batching Plant)
 - b. DA - Material Change of Use Development Permit - Industry: STAGE 1 - Schedule 2 Industry (CSR Concrete Batching Plant)
 - c. DA - Material Change of Use Development Permit - Industry: STAGE 2 - Schedule 2 Industry (CSR Concrete Batching Plant)

The conditions of approval have been released to our agent on the agreement between council and CSR. Bill Walsh will report the outcome.

CSR 2 or Edenbrook Creekside. Development Application 946551- re-zone of land from Emerging Community to Industrial_– Update on progress.
